### Who's eligible

The fund is open to applications from airfield owners, operators and airfield-associated businesses. To qualify for support, the application must concern either a licensed or unlicensed UK airfield that has handled fewer than 200,000 passengers on average during the last two financial years, and the annual passenger traffic for this financial year is not expected to exceed 200,000.

To qualify for support, the application must concern an UK airfield that:

- Handles less than 200,000 terminal passengers per calendar year, excluding 2020.
